Advent is just around the corner! (First Sunday of Advent is December 1st) **We are looking for 12 families** to lead us in the Jesse Tree Devotion as part of each of the four Sundays in Advent. The Jesse Tree is an Advent Tree. As we prepare for the coming of Jesus, we will reflect on the holy men and women who came before Jesus.
