Grief to Grace

Grief to Grace is a 4 day psychological and spiritual journey providing safety and support to anyone who has suffered degradation or violation through physical, emotional or sexual abuse or neglect. It is appropriate for those who have endured rape, incest, or other forms of traumatic violence in childhood, adolescence or as an adult. It is also suitable for those who may have suffered abuse by a member of the clergy. The program is designed to help you experience the love and support of the suffering body of Christ as you journey through the Pascal mystery of your own life. This effective healing process combines Living Scripture with journaling, group activity and discussion, therapeutic facilitation, cognitive restructuring and grief work.
