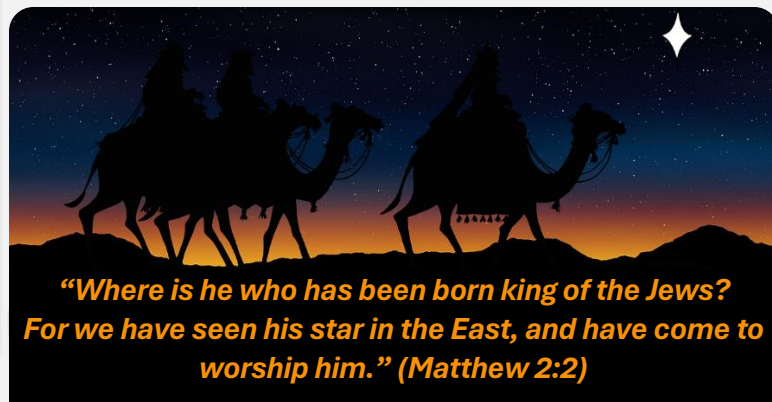

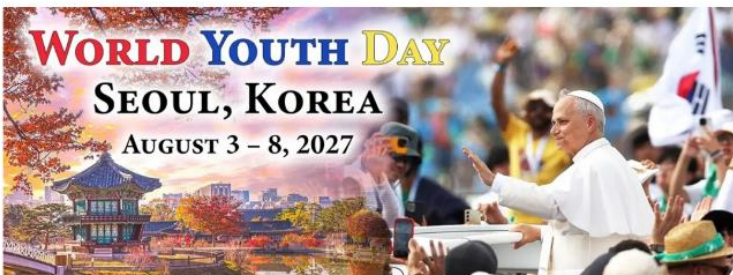

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

The Epiphany of the Lord Jesus is also known as 'The Revelation of Christ to the World'. The visit of the Magi brings home the message of universality of the human race. Christ is born for all. God is for all people. He, the Almighty, is not only God for the Jews, but He is God for all. The visit of the Magi has been understood as the fulfillment of the Scriptures especially Psalm 72 and Isaiah 60:1-6 which reads, "Kings will come from far off lands with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh to David's Son, to the City of the Lord." The Gospel of Matthew refers to the Magi as 'Wise men from the East', which would mean that they had come from the direction of 'The Rising Sun'. According to tradition, these Kings were named Melchior (King of Persia), Caspar (King of India) and Balthazar (King of Arabia). These illustrious personalities had brought fitting gifts and presents for the Christ Child: gold, referring to His Royalty, frankincense, honouring His Divinity and myrrh, recognizing His Humanity.

It's worth remembering that these Wisemen were guided by 'The Star', a natural phenomenon. Their curiosity stirred them to undertake an unexpected and hazardous journey without any modern device like GPS to navigate their whereabouts. We are wonderstruck with their courage for such an adventure when they had no aircraft or jets to cross the mountain terrain and the body of waters. Our curiosity is stirred to wonder at, and ask the question, where did they lodge and what food did they eat? Being kings, they would have had an entourage (but there's no reference about that at all). The Bible just mentions that they came from the East... (From different directions, representing God's people from the World.) But they converged at Bethlehem. Certainly, the Magi had not met each other earlier or communicated with one another.

But one thing seems to be clear that 'Divine providence guided them'. That providence is the "Star of Bethlehem", Jesus Christ, our Saviour is the Star, and He enlightens everyone who seeks him with a sincere heart. Paul in the letter to the Ephesians 1:18 wrote, "Let the eye of my mind be opened". The Magi sought the Lord sincerely and found Him at the Manger with his Mother Mary, and shared their joy-filled presents.

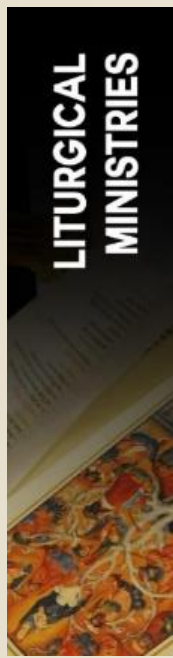
Today's feast of the Epiphany invites us also to seek the Lord sincerely and be enlightened by His Divine Grace. If we have the right motives and intentions to explore the unknown, God will certainly be with us to help achieve our hopes and dreams. His Providence will take us to the right place for achieving our hopes and dreams. God will take care of our ways and needs and will be able open new doors in our life to find Him. May the good Lord help us with this initiative on this wonderful Feast of Epiphany.
