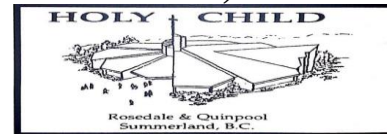

However, having the door to the sacristy opening right off the foyer makes it difficult for our celebrants and members of the liturgical team to spiritually prepare for the celebration of Mass. Members of the Parish Pastoral Team have discussed this issue and subsequently recommended to Fr.Ben that the foyer entrance to the sacristy be closed prior to and after Mass.

Those involved in the day's liturgy will access the sacristy via the chapel. This will allow our parishoners to continue to meet and greet each other while allowing others to prepare appropriately for the Mass. If you would like to speak to Fr.
