

## **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Saint Helena, the Queen Mother of Constantine the Great, found the 'True Cross of Christ' in the year 362 AD and built a church (Church of the Sepulcher) on that site. Today's Feast of the 'Holy Cross' celebrates Christ's Victory over sin and death. (1Cor 15:12-19) The Holy Cross has become an instrument of our Salvation. This instrument, which was considered a device of torture in the past, has been acclaimed to be a 'Life-Giving Tree' for the believers. The Cross is the Universal Symbol / Image of Christian belief all over the world. Artists throughout the centuries have transformed it into a thing of beauty to be carried in procession or worn as jewelry. For the eyes of the first Christians, it had no beauty. But today it stands out as a symbol of grace, welcoming everyone to his all-embracing love.

Crucifixes in homes, schools, offices, and other prominent places proclaim loud and clear the Saving Love of Christ, bearing constant witness to His Life and Death, reminding us of our Faith. The Cross of Christ is not just a piece of wood. It's a symbolic summary of his suffering, death and resurrection, by which we have been redeemed. It expresses our faith in the crucified Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Pope Francis once mentioned that 'Wearing the Cross is good, but following the Cross is better'. People who love much, sacrifice much (Jn 3:16), yet sacrifices do not make us poorer but richer.


The image of the Cross was a Stumbling Block to the Jews, wrote Apostle Paul in Gal 6:12-13. The Cross made the Jewish Circumcision unnecessary (1 Cor 1:23 and Phil 3:18) as the Judaizers insisted on circumcision and a few other legal obligations. For believers, the Cross means the whole Christ Event' (Gal 6:14) through which the world has been crucified to Him and We to the World'. The Jewish Circumcision has been replaced by the New Creation (2 Cor 5:17) Christ through His Death and Resurrection, transformed us as New Creatures = The Redeemed Community, by giving us rebirth through Water and Spirit.

Christian Life is a call to take up one's Cross = Discipleship or Stewardship (Mk 10:38), initiating 'Renunciation'. The Gospel of Luke 9:23 invites us to 'Take up our Cross daily and come after the Lord' (Follow Christ with our daily struggles and challenges). The Holy Cross offers 'Reconciliation'. The Christ event was for the reconciliation of the World to God the Father and also to reconcile with one another = to make peace with our friends and families, as Paul wrote in Ephesians 2:14, "Jesus is our Peace". Christians share in the suffering of Christ through their daily crosses (Col 1:24). We have to suffer until the end of the World.

Jesus' Cross has the salvific power (Rm 4:25). It was an instrument of Curse as per Deuteronomy 21:23. It was used to punish the worst criminals. That's why the Jewish people could not accept the death of Jesus on the Cross. For them, the Messiah cannot die on the Cross, therefore, the Cross became a stumbling block. (1 Cor 1:23) But Paul experienced this Christ on the way to Damascus, and appreciated His redeeming Words: "I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom you are persecuting". Like Paul, we are invited by the Church to realize the 'redeeming Power of Christ's Cross in our lives'.


