

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Scripture Message for 20th August 2023 (20th Sunday Ordinary time)

"Does God answer our prayers?" seems to be the question many/all of us have. Mark 11:24 answers, "Ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours". Again Matthew 7:7 reiterates, "Ask and you will receive. Search you will find. Knock and the door will be opened. For the one who asks, always receives. The one who searches, finds. The one who knocks, will have the door opened for him". If our prayer request is according to God's Holy Will and if it is beneficial for our growth, God grants them. If they are not, God takes time (he decides according to His good pleasure and not according to our demands/urgency. But He always assures us of His grace. "His grace is sufficient for us" (2 Cor 12:9)

"What is Prayer?" Prayer is a human experience. It's also a Christian experience. In prayer we express our dependency on a Higher Power (God/Deity) which is our guiding principle. We have the inclination/urge to pray because of our affiliation with the Deity. We have this privilege of asking God for blessings and favours. We cannot control God or dictate to him as to what He should do or should not do for us and to the world at large. We pray for several years depending on God's Mercy/benevolence, but nothing happens. Then we are frustrated. We feel that our prayer requests are unanswered/unheeded and our circumstances remain unchanged. Oftentimes we complain that God does not seem to be responding. This situation is festering in our heart, mind and soul. St. Paul explained this situation as 'thorn in one's flesh' (2 Cor 12:7-9)

"Does prayer give a turning point in our lives?". If we are able to depend & allow ourselves to go according to the Plans of God, we all can have a 'turning point' in life. Like Jesus, we should be able to respond, "not my Will, but let thy Will be done". (Lk 22:42) Jesus shows us the way out from our challenges. Jesus saw his imminent death, he was completely challenged, devastated, frustrated and annoyed even beyond his endurance. Yet he trusted in the goodness of God, His Father (Mt 26:38-39) Jesus had built an abiding relationship with His Father God. (Jn 15:7) Abiding becomes a harmonious blending of heart & mind. It makes us tuned to God's Will. When we reach this stage, we begin to depend on God fully well and realize that God listens to our prayers.

Ps 34:18 Tells, "God listens to the Cry of the Poor".... especially the helpless, hopeless, the powerless & lifeless (the anawim of God). "What then Prayer is?". Prayer is waiting on God with eager expectation and longing. Whenever our prayer is persistent and sincere, God listens to the cry of the heart. (Ex : 1. The Canaanite Woman (Mt 15; 21-28) & 2. Abraham's Waiting for an offspring, Issac (Ge 17) prayer also deepens our relationship with God. The Divine Mercy Prayer of Sr. Faustina deepens our relationship with Christ, because it is not born out of material gains, considerations, but it is the pure manifestation of our Genuine Love.

Prayer also helps us to Surrender & Trust more in the Almighty Power of the Deity. The exemplary Trust of Job in the goodness of God is felt when we read, "The Lord gave & He has taken away. Praised be thy Holy Name". (Job 1:21) For the unshakable Trust of Job, the good Lord returned, "Double Portion" of all that job had lost (Job 42:10) Therefore let us try to depend on the Lord with all our prayer petitions, intercessions and requests, always believing that he will grant us His Blessings in due time!
