

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Blessed the people God has called his own" (Ps: 33) God Creates history and history belongs to God. In fact, God controls history. Therefore, people are encouraged to express their faith and friendship to the Lord. We are recommended to be loyal and obedient to Him. We should remember the mercies of the Lord all through our existence. The Hebrew people remembered the mercies of the Lord, recalling the untimely plagues they experienced. (Exodus 9-11) According to Ex 12:29-33 Yahweh (Supreme God of the Hebrews) struck down all the first born in the land of Egypt. (Humans & Animals) The Egyptian Pharaoh killed the Hebrew male children, when they increased in numbers. (Ex 1:16), but the God of Israel spared the Hebrews from drowning at the Red Sea allowing the Egyptians to die with their chariots. God's benevolence is greatly remembered in all these actions by the Hebrews. Nothing goes unnoticed by God. The Almighty is aware of everything.
