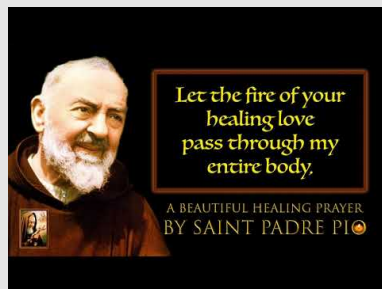

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL
