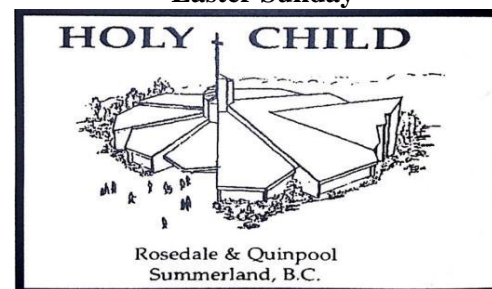

Easter Message

From Your Pastor

“There is a season for everything,” says the Book of Ecclesiastes. There is a season to be born. There is a season for dying. There is a season for planting. There is a season for harvesting. Indeed, for everything there is a season and a reason.

The Catholic Church has its own seasons, too, in celebrating the liturgy. On each season, Jesus comes to us with grace. The Advent season is a time of particular grace for us, offering us the grace of joyful expectation. Christmas season gives us the joy and grace of knowing that God has become one of us. The Lenten season gives us the grace of repentance as we meditate on the Passion of Jesus. The Easter season brings us the grace of hope as we look forward to the day that we will all share the gift of the resurrection of Jesus. Easter brings us hope in our day-to-day life, assuring us of God’s presence in our midst.

For five Sundays we have prepared ourselves for the celebration of Easter. This is the biggest season we celebrate in the Church—the resurrection of our Redeemer Jesus Christ. My homilies should have guided you in your Lenten journey, and I hope that you are now ready to welcome and praise the Lord on His resurrection.

This is the good news for all of us. The Risen Lord is with us in the ups and downs of our life. He is always there ready to lift us up especially in our moments of sufferings. The Lord is risen. Alleluia! We are an alleluia people. We are filled with happiness and gratitude because the Lord rose from the dead to give us life. Day by day, with every season that comes along, let us always celebrate the life Jesus has given us, especially in the Holy Eucharist.
