Many parishoners at Holy Child have received an email this week that says “Hi, how are you doing? I need a favor from you, email me as soon as you get this message” and is signed from “Fr.Ben Buela”. The scam artists have even set up a gmail account that is under Fr.Ben's name , so the email is very deceptive. If you respond to this first email it is followed by a request for you to buy a \$500 gift card for Fr.Ben. **THESE EMAILS ARE NOT FROM FR.BEN. DO NOT RESPOND TO THEM.** In fact, be very very cautious in responding to any email that appears to be from a priest in our Diocese, as this scam email has been a problem throughout the Diocese of Nelson.
