

CHAPEL & PRAYER CANDLES

*Please make the most of our prayer/votive
candles in the chapel.*

Sometimes candles are lit for an individual. This may be for the soul of a deceased loved one or someone who is sick. Prayers are said for those in need of divine intervention or a divine blessing. Individuals also light prayer candles when seeking divine guidance. The lighting of a votive candle isn't always in a prayer of request. Sometimes candles can be lit in gratitude of blessings received.

The lighting of a candle symbolizes our faith burning brightly and our desire for God to illuminate our lives. The candle's light represents Christ, the Light of the world (John 8:12) and reminds us of God's presence in our lives. It is also a sign of prayer and offering, as the flame consumes itself while our prayers rise to heaven like incense before the Lord (Psalm 141:2).

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Invitation to follow Jesus" is the timely message for this week. We all have our recreational activities like fishing, skating, running or walking and so on. The Gospel of Mathew 4:19 calls us to follow him, not as a recreational activity, but as a lifelong endeavour, "Come follow me and I will make you fishers of people." Fishing was a lucrative business during Jesus' time. (Fishing and salting for preservation was a thriving business as per Jewish history.) Jesus met four fishermen from the fishing industry (Andrew, Simon, John and James) as his first disciples, who were seasoned by the winds and waves of life. The metaphor 'fishing in troubled waters' sends a clear message to the level-headed people and so we are advised by the good Lord not to fish in troubled waters. Jesus had a captivating personality and charisma to get such a committed group of people to begin His Mission.

Jesus met these men at their business centres and called them, "Come, I will make you fishers of people" (Mt 4:19). They left their nets, boats, business and families to follow him. Such an instantaneous response of the first disciples seems to be very surprising to the modern believers. 'How could that be?' is our surprising comment, even today. But that's what had happened. Jesus went to the shore of Galilee and saw them mending their nets...i.e., being engaged in their business. Pope Francis often reminded us, 'Go to the peripheries and meet your people and engage them.' Jesus invited Apostle Matthew, when he was at his tax office in Capernaum. Matthew left his lucrative business and came after Jesus. Every time, Jesus called someone, they all left their productive activities and followed Him, especially Mary Magdalene.

'Why are we not successful?' As we look around the modern world, we see the aging clergy all over and the church congregations are becoming smaller and smaller. Oftentimes, we are lamenting that people are leaving the Church and not many new members are added to our congregation. Probably, Jesus is telling us that we need to go to their work spots and extend an invitation, especially to the professionals like, the medical personnel, police or military officers, teachers, mechanics, engineers, officers, artists, farm workers, students and so on. Probably they may consider the call. Jesus' message of the day is, 'Call them from the cross-roads.' As the first disciples came and saw the Lord in his place and stayed with him, not for a day or two, but for their entire life..., our new friends may also have the same grace to stay with Him for life. So, Jesus is giving us a clue this Sunday. 'Invite them to come and see the Lord'. Our concerted efforts in this direction may benefit the Church greatly.

There are 400,000 parish priests working around the globe in the parish ministry. There are also several thousands of religious men and women in the world doing wonderful humanitarian and spiritual services to the marginalized and segregated people of our times. All these have heard the Divine Call and responded positively, and optimistically willing to offer their committed services. Today, let's thank them profoundly for their responses and also pray for our modern world to respond to the needs of the Church at this time. Let people of good will and calibre join the 'Team of Christ', like the 'First Disciples of Christ' to form a 'Core Group' to transform this world through the principles of Love and Service!


