

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Sharing of our Faith through Caring" is the theme for this Sunday.

Saint Pauline Marie Jaricot, a French National, in 1822, founded the 'Propagation of Faith' (Mission Sunday) at the age of 23. As a young woman, she volunteered to support missionary endeavours around the World. Today, we gather to pray for the missions and the missionaries around the World, who expressed their deep love for Christ and His Church. We also explore the possibility of helping the missionary apostolate of the Church through our timely charity and sharing of resources. We play a vital role in the transformation of modern society, to have a shift from hostility to friendship, from hatred to solidarity.

About 120 countries join their missionary mandate from around the world, contributing towards this noble purpose. We are invited to join hands with our brothers and sisters to serve others through our timely sharing and caring mission. Our missionaries reach out to those in need (spiritual and temporal), alleviating their pain and turmoil. There are 440,000 Parish Priests around the world, as per the Vatican Statistics, but some are in squalid conditions, especially in war-torn regions. They have rough and tough times in the hands of the hostile and unstable political environment...most often inimical to our faith principles. We need to support and encourage them through our goodwill and timely care. Some do not even have the basic facilities to survive, like transportation, medical assistance and housing. We need to supply them with adequate vehicles and health facilities to carry on their missionary activities. As Christ became the voice of the voiceless and defender of the defenceless, we are commissioned to care for Missionaries and their people.

Missionary endeavour extends to law firms, healthcare facilities, education, housing, Faith Formation, and fostering civilization. We pioneer in several other modern activities too, like giving support to the LGBT, homeless, orphans, single parents and the care of the elderly. Mission Sunday is a Global concerted effort to make the Gospel of Christ available to all sectors of the population. We are encouraged to support through our Sunday Mass offerings, prayers, gifts and above all with our prayers and goodwill.

We are called to be disciples of Christ. Our discipleship should display a radical counter-cultural attitude towards leadership as per the Gospel of Matthew 10:35-45. There's no place for self-promotion, rivalry or domineering conduct among the believers, explains the gospel today. Aspiring for greatness is deep down in every human heart, but disciples are encouraged to imitate Jesus closely (Phil 2:2-5) through self-emptying love. Let our leadership be expressed in service to the Lord and His People. Let our service be entirely for the benefit of others. Let's put ourselves at the service of others, to care for their humblest needs. 'Let's begin to wash each other's feet', says the Pope. Let's wait at the table and share the passion of the people each day! We are called to be ambassadors of Christ's redemptive death. Let's become salvation to others by lending our flesh as Jesus.


