## **HEALTH ORDER UPDATE**

Dear Priests and Parishes,

Peace! There was an update provided on Tuesday, Feb. 15 (expires June 30, 2022) by the Public Health Officer regarding events/gatherings. Bishop Bittman provides the following information on how it affects our parishes/diocesan properties:

Parish Halls:

- May now be used at full capacity for events including funeral receptions, weddings, parties, parish breakfasts, meetings, etc., as long as everyone is fully vaccinated and vaccination passports are verified (scanned) and IDs are checked by organizers. BC Vaccine Passport Scanner may be downloaded from the App Store for your device. Masks must be worn at all times unless actively eating or drinking. Dancing is allowed.
- Those who are not yet fully vaccinated may attend indoor events/meetings via Zoom if it is offered.

Mass:

- No changes since the last update in December, but Dr. Henry indicated she will review faith based orders by mid-March.
- All are welcome
- 50% capacity in the church
- Masks must be worn at all times over nose and mouth except when consuming the Holy Eucharist.
- Choirs, music ministry must also be masked at all times other than when consuming the Holy Eucharist; a soloist (no other singers) may unmask while actively singing, socially distanced from others.
