PASTORAL CARE TRAINING SESSIONS

Care Outreach Training series will be offered online again this fall.

Nine sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 - noon, starting on September 24, 2022, and running until November 26 (with no session on October 8 for Thanksgiving).

Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion.

Whether you are a member of your parish Pastoral Care Team, an Extraordinary Minister of Communion, a member of the Knights of Columbus, CWL or St. Vincent de Paul, clergy or religious, caring for a family member, or someone who is considering simply adding these skills to their toolbox, this training program is important. It will show why those who visit the sick are unique, and how they can offer more than a friendly visit - they can be the hands and face of Christ to others. Until pastoral access to homes, hospitals, nursing homes, and health care facilities is fully available, Bishop Gary Gordon (of the Diocese of Victoria) feels "it is important to have parishioners trained at the ready to provide a caring and compassionate experience to those who are most in need."
